### Step 3


Fold the tabs and stick them on to the side of the toilet roll.

### Step 2



Paint the toilet roll and all the pieces.

Add the eyes, either googly eyes if you have them, white stickers, or cut out small bits of white paper and stick them on.




Ears

## Step 1

## Step 3




Glue the mane to the front.

## Step 1

Using the stencils, cut out the ears and trunk from the side of a cereal box.

Paint the toilet roll and all the pieces.


## Step 3
