Use the suffix 'ly' .

Adverbs describe verbs. Most adverbs end in 'ly'.

Rule: If a word ends with **le** (simple**le**) you change the **e** and just add a **y** (simple**ly**). If a word ends in a **y** and has more than 1 syllable (stea**dy**) you change the **y** to an **i** and add **ly** (stea**dily**). In almost all other cases, just add **ly** to the end of the word.

Exceptions are: **daily**, **truly**, **duly**.
