This week, we would like you to learn about homophones. As we explained in class, homophones are words that sounds the same but are spelt differently and have different meanings.

**For instance:**

The rain was pouring from the looming, grey clouds.

Queen Elizabeth's reign has been very long.

**Green:** Just learn the green words and write them into 5 sentences.
