Use prefixes ‘un’ ‘dis’ ‘mis’ ‘re’ ‘pre’

Prefixes are small add-ons to the beginning of words. They change the meaning of the root word. Their meanings differ: ‘un-’, ‘mis-’ and ‘dis-’ prefixes often reverse the meanings of the root word or indicate a negative. A ‘re-’ prefix indicates a repeat, while a ‘pre’ prefix means before (as in prehistoric, which means before recorded history).
