

Use suffixes beginning with vowel letters at the end of words with more than one syllable.

Rules: Suffixes are small add-ons to the end of words. The silent 'e' at the end of the root word is dropped when adding a suffix beginning with a vowel letter (e.g. 'nicest'). When a word ends in y, change the y to 'i' before the suffix is added but not before 'ing'. (e.g. 'happiest'). Double the consonant before the vowel consonant if:
 a) the word ends with one vowel and a consonant (e.g. -at, -en) , b) has more than one syllable,
 c) when the last syllable is stressed (e.g. forgot or channel).
