Rule: This week's endings are **-able** and **-ible**. A general **rule** is if we take away the **suffix (-able)** we are usually left with a root **word**: understandable = understand + **able**, enjoyable = enjoy + **able**, comfortable = comfort + **able**, dependable = depend + **able**

For five of your words only, write five sentences in the front of your homework book. This week you must include a different modal verb in each sentence and underline it.
