

Spelling Rule:

This week, we would like you to look at words that end in the suffix –ssion which sounds like ‘shun’. We use the suffix ‘ssion’ when the root word ends in ‘ss’ or ‘t’. **For example express – expression and commit – commission**

We have also included some common exception words as well.

Green: Just learn the green words and write them into 5 sentences.
