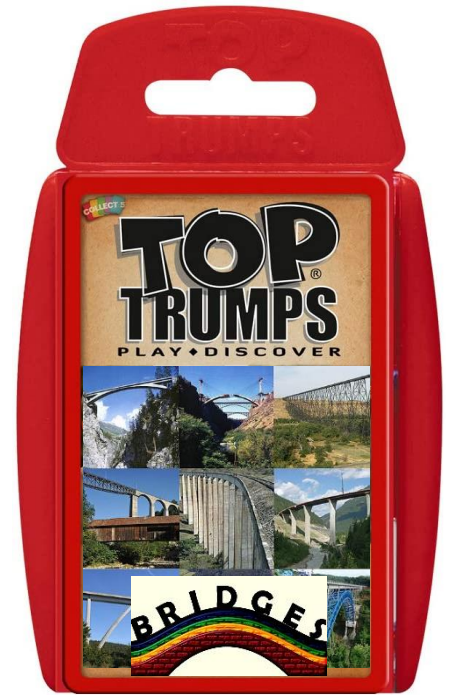



TOP TRUMPS®
