

Rule: This week we have been learning about prefixes particularly -il, -im, -ir, and -in.

We know if the root word begins with 'l' we use -il .

If the root word begins with 'r' add -ir.

If the root words begins with 'm' or 'p' add -im

If the root word begins with any other letter we add -in
