

**Spelling Rule:**

This week, we would like you to look at words that end with the 'us' sound. This can be spelled as 'ous' although sometimes you need to add an extra letter.

If the root word ends in 'our' e.g. humour we remove the 'our' add 'or' and then add 'ous' = humorous.

If the root word ends in 'ge' we keep this and add e.g. 'ous' courage +ous = courageous

If there is an /i:/ sound before the -ous ending, it is usually spelt as i e.g. various, previous

**Green:** Just learn the green words and write them into 5 sentences.
