Spelling Rule: This week we would like you to revise **-tion, -ssion, -sion and -cian** words

Don't forget

-tion is used if the root word ends in t or te.

-sion is mostly used if the root word ends in d or se

-ssion is used if the root word ends in ss or -mit.

-cian is used if the root word ends in c or cs
