gue - The letter u acts as a wall and stops the g from making its soft sound.

que - In these words the letters **que** make the sound /k/ at the end of the word.

Blue Spelling Group: Learn all the words and write them into 5 sentences.

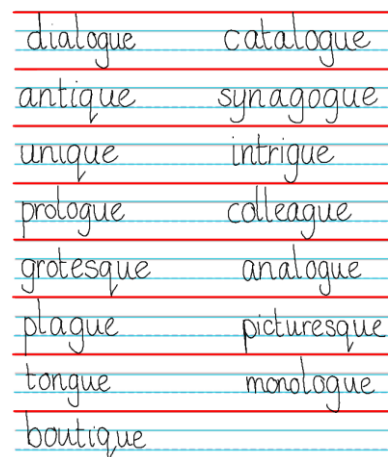
Remember you may need to look some of these words up in a dictionary so that you know what they mean for your sentences!
