Green (old Green spelling group): Just learn the green words and write them into 5 sentences.

Both **Green** and **Blue** are to learn the 5 statutory words.

Blue (old Yellow and Blue spelling groups): Learn the green and blue words and write them into 5 sentences.

Children will also be given two 'unseen words' during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week's spelling rule.

Green: Tested on 12 words in total.

Blue: Tested on 15 words in total.

Spellings: Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

Sentence grammar focus: For five chosen words, write five sentences that use an apostrophe to show either singular or plural possession, e.g. the pilot's submarine (singular) OR the pilots' submarine (plural.)

Remember to make sure you are **writing neatly** and using **all appropriate punctuation**.
