

## Year 2 Spellings Autumn 2: Week 1

**Rule:**  
To spell words where 'dge' makes a /j/ sound.

**Statutory:**

1 judge

2 lodge

3 ridge

4 dodge

5 wedge

6 hedge

7 fridge

8 pledge

**Green:** Just learn the green words and write them into 3 sentences.

Both **Green** and **Blue** are to learn the 5 statutory words.

**Blue:** Learn the green and blue words and write them into 3 sentences.

Children will also be given two 'unseen words' during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week's spelling rule.

**Green:** Tested on 12 words in total.

**Blue:** Tested on 15 words in total.

**Spellings:** Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

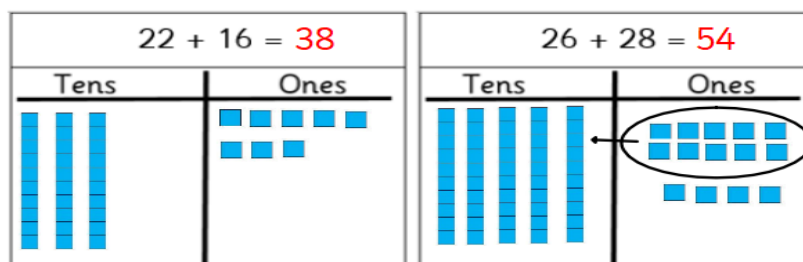
**Sentence grammar focus:** For three chosen words, write three sentences that include an expanded noun phrase.

The gigantic, sturdy fridge was made twenty-five years ago.

Remember to make sure you are **writing neatly** and using **all appropriate punctuation**

The arithmetic task is in addition to the Mathematics activities that your child has been set from the Add and Subtract unit

Either practise adding a two digit and a one digit number ( $15 + 6$ ) or two 2-digit numbers (see below). Remember to add the ones first and then the tens. If you would like, you can draw a picture of the tens and ones to help you using one colour for the starting number and a different colour for the number that you are adding.



**Challenge:** Can you add three 2-digit numbers?
