

## Year 2 Spellings Autumn 2: Week 3

**Rule:**  
To spell words where 'g' makes a /j/ sound.

**Statutory:**

1 gem

2 magic

3 digit

4 gentle

5 giant

6 energy

7 engine

8 religion

beautiful

could

sure

kind

only

**Green:** Just learn the green words and write them into 3 sentences.

Both **Green** and **Blue** are to learn the 5 statutory words.

**Blue:** Learn the green and blue words and write them into 3 sentences.

Children will also be given two 'unseen words' during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week's spelling rule.

**Green:** Tested on 12 words in total.

**Blue:** Tested on 15 words in total.

**Spellings:** Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

**Sentence grammar focus:** For three chosen words, write three sentences that include commas in a list.

The gigantic, troublesome **giant** ate cabbage, chicken, potatoes and broccoli.

Remember to make sure you are **writing neatly** and using **all appropriate punctuation**

The arithmetic task is in addition to the Mathematics activities that your child has been set from the Add and Subtract unit

Draw the tens and ones to help you with the following addition and subtraction calculations:

$21 + 8 = \underline{\quad}$

$45 + 20 = \underline{\quad}$

$49 - 8 = \underline{\quad}$

$57 - 26 = \underline{\quad}$

$41 + 16 = \underline{\quad}$

$34 + 17 = \underline{\quad}$

### Challenge

Use these sets of three numbers to make four calculations (two should be subtraction, two addition):

45, 55, 100

100, 90, 10

20, 15, 5

100, 65, 35
