<p>Green: Just learn the green words and write them into 3 sentences.</p> <p>Blue: Learn the green and blue words and write them into 3 sentences.</p>		Both Green and Blue are to learn the 5 statutory words.

Children will also be given two 'unseen words' during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week's spelling rule.

Green: Tested on 12 words in total.

Blue: Tested on 15 words in total.

Spellings: Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

Sentence grammar focus: For three chosen words, write three sentences that include an adverb.

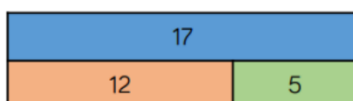
The excited, energetic child ran to the **circus** quickly.

For example:



$$12 + 5 = 17$$

$$5 + 12 = 17$$

$$17 - 5 = 12$$

$$17 - 12 = 5$$
