<b>Spring term 2022</b>		
H&F Netball Tournament	15 children	A and B team played in the H&F tournament – the A team went on to represent Hammersmith & Fulham at the London Youth Games, and won this competition (which had 32 London Boroughs competing).
H&F Year 5/6 Sportshall Athletics	40 children	A and B team competed; the A team came second overall in the Borough.
H&F Year 3/4 Indoor Athletics	30 children	All children in this team hadn't competed before in a Borough event.
H&F Panathlon (Years 3-6)	6 Children	Eligibility criteria for this team: KS2 children on the SEN register.
H&F Basketball	20 children	A and B team played; the A team were runners-up, narrowly losing in the final.
Year 6 Tag-Rugby v Wetherby	20 children	Friendly: three mixed teams played.
Visit from sports star Ezekiel Ewolu	Whole school	Ezekiel Ewolu, international athlete, gave an inspirational and entertaining assembly. Throughout the morning, all children from Reception through to Year 6 had a short fitness circuit session with Ezekiel.
Visit from Eric Shirley	Whole school	Eric is a grandparent of children in the school and has been involved in British Athletics throughout his career, including being Olympic team manager. Eric entertained various classes giving talks about his time involved with athletics.

Year 6 Cricket v Wetherby	20 children	Friendly: A team played hard ball, B team mixed ability girls and boys.
Year 3/4 Cricket v Wetherby	24 children	Friendly: three mixed ability girls and boys teams.
H& F Year 3 Skittleball	6 children	Selected A team for H&F Competition (unbeaten).
H&F Year 4 Skittleball	8 children	Selected A team for H&F Competition (came second in group).
H&F Tag Rugby Tournament Years 5/6	18 children	A and B Team competed. Both teams got to the final; the A team won, the B team came second. The A team qualified for the West London Games where they lost very narrowly in the final to a very strong team.
H& F Mini-red Tennis Tournament Years 3/4	8 children	A and B team of children selected from those who attend the after school tennis club. The A team won and then competed in the London Youth Games later in the term where they had a very enjoyable day of tennis (and came third in their group).
H&F Mini-orange Tennis Tournament Year 5/6	8 children	A and B team of children selected from those who attend after school tennis club. The A team came second overall.

Year 4 Wetherby Cricket Tournament	18 children	Selected two mixed teams to play in this tournament but it was cancelled due to rain
Year 5 Cricket v Wetherby	24 children	Friendly: one A team (mixed hard ball), then two mixed ability girls and boys teams
H&F Year 5/6 Girls Cricket	20 children	Took two teams, all girls who don't play cricket or compete regularly. Format was uncompetitive festival.
H&F Year 5/6 Boys Cricket	20 children	A team competed, plus a second team made up at the very last minute on the morning when another team pulled out. The A team won the final against St Peter's and qualified for the West London Games finals.
H&F Year 3/4 Quad Kids	20 children	A and B team competed (A team won, B team third).
H&F Year 5/6 Quad Kids Athletics	10 children	A team competed.
West London Games Finals	Winning teams from H&F competitions	Took our winning teams from Borough competitions to: Netball Finals (mixed) Boys' cricket finals Girls' cricket finals Tag Rugby (mixed) Finals
Sports Awards Evening	140 children	Annual Sports Awards – over the academic year 2021-2022, 140 different children from Years 3-6 have competed in at least one H&F Borough Sports Competition, including 100% of Year 6, 65% of Year 5 and 65% of Year 4.

Various football friendlies against Wetherby for Years 4, 5 and 6	90 children	28-30 children from each year group
Friendly – Year 3/4 netball vs Greenside	22 children	Mixed ability teams
Friendly – Year 2 Skittleball vs Greenside	20 children	Mixed ability teams
Tournament – Under 11 EFL Qualifier	10 children	We took a competitive squad of 8 to this 6-a-side event, which is the first round of a competition to find a team to represent QPR in a regional then national tournament. The team played very well to reach the finals, but lost in the final to a stronger team (Holy Cross). As runners-up, they will qualify to play in the QPR finals in January.
Tournament – Year 5/6 netball	50 children	Year 5 and 6 each played in netball tournaments in Ravenscourt Park organised by Ravenscourt Prep School. To each tournament we took an A, B and C team (21-25 children in each of Year 5 and 6).

Tournament – Year 5/6 football	60 children	Year 5 and 6 were each meant to play in a football tournament organised by Ravenscourt Prep School. We selected an A, B and C team for each one, but both tournaments had to be cancelled due to waterlogged pitches. They are hopefully being re-arranged for early next term (30 children in each of Year 5 and 6)
Tournament – Year 3 children	12 children	Tournament held at Sunningdale Prep, mixed girls and boys teams. Teams selected based on skills shown in PE.
Tournament – Year 2 football festival	9 Children	Organised by QPR. Teams selected based on skills shown in PE.
H&F 5KM challenge	40 children	We took a Year 5 and a Year 6 team to this inclusive and less competitive event, where each member of the team had to run 100m a few times, in order to accumulate a team total of 5000m.
H&F Year 5/6 Sportshall athletics	18 children	We took a competitive Year 5/6 team and won the event (by a matter of a couple of points over St John's Walham). They have qualified to represent Hammersmith & Fulham in the Regional qualifiers as part of the London Youth Games.
H&F Year 6 dodgeball	20 children	We took two teams to this event, ensuring that all Year 6s have already this year competed in at least one H&F Borough event.
Panathlon	6 children	Eligibility criteria for this team: KS2 children on the SEN register. We took 6 children from Years 3-6 who were delighted to come back to school with their bronze medals.
Mayor's Cup Football	15 children	We enter a girls' team and a boys' team in the competition. (Last year we were very lucky to be allowed two teams of each, which we tried to do again this year, but the leagues were full).  The format is a round robin, where we play each team in the group (eight matches) over the course of the first two terms of the year (between September and March). They have started the year fantastically well, the boys being unbeaten and the girls winning all of their matches, putting them both in a strong position to come in the top two in their groups, which would mean going through to the knock-out stages.
H&F Year 3/4 Sportshall athletics	18 children	A competitive team, selected using time trials from last term, came first in the Borough.
Intra-school event – Year 1 mini-football	Whole year group	Mini-football and multisports tournament at the Power League pitches.
Intra-school event – Year 2 mini-football	Whole year group	Mini-football and multisports tournament at the Power League pitches.
Intra-school event – KS2 cross country running	Whole year groups	Competitive run of between 600-1000m depending on year group; gold, silver and bronze medals awarded to the first three girls and first three boys in each year.
Intra-school event – Year 4 multi sports strip	Whole year group	All children played various sports on a rotation, including cricket, tag rugby, football and fives.
