Green (old Green spelling group): Just learn the green words and write them into 5 sentences.

Both **Green** and **Blue** are to learn the 5 statutory words.

Blue (old Yellow and Blue spelling groups): Learn the green and blue words and write them into 5 sentences.

Children will also be given two 'unseen words' during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week's spelling rule.

Green: Tested on 12 words in total.

Blue: Tested on 15 words in total.

Spellings: Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

Sentence grammar focus: For five chosen words, write five sentences that include a relative clause (also known as a 'drop-in' clause.) Make sure your relative clause is clear by putting a comma before and after it.

For example:

The **curious** man, who was 27 years old, explored the forest.

Remember to make sure you are **writing neatly** and using **all appropriate punctuation**.
