Purple: Please learn the **Purple** words and write them into 5 sentences.

Red: Please learn the **Purple** and **Red** words and write them into 5 sentences.

Both **Purple** and **Red** are to learn the 5 statutory words.

Children will also be given two 'unseen words' during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week's spelling rule.

Purple: Tested on 12 words in total.

Red: Tested on 15 words in total.

Spellings: Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

Sentence grammar focus: For five chosen words, write five sentences that make use of the possessive apostrophe (either singular or plural).

For example: Mr Faith's son **bravely** got up and carried on after falling off of his scooter at the weekend (true story).

Remember to make sure you are **writing neatly** and using **all appropriate punctuation**.
