Green: Tested on 12 words in total.

Blue: Tested on 15 words in total.

Spellings: Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

Sentence grammar focus: Using at least **5 chosen words**, write 5 sentences using **parenthesis**.

Remember: Parenthesis adds additional information to a noun and must be within either commas, dashes or brackets.

E.g.

The children were extremely excited about their **residential (which was taking place in the remote Welsh mountains)**. They were hoping the weather would be pleasant **- without torrential rain -** with challenging, adventurous activities.

Remember to make sure you are **writing neatly** and using **all appropriate punctuation**.
