Purple: Tested on 12 words in total.

Red: Tested on 15 words in total.

Sentence grammar focus: For five chosen words, write five sentences that make good use of fronted adverbials.

For example: On a cold winter's morning, the nervous warrior headed off into battle.

Remember to make sure you are **writing neatly** and using **all appropriate punctuation**.
