Green: Just learn the green words and write them into 5 sentences. Blue: Learn the green and blue words and write them into 5 sentences.	Both Green and Blue are to learn the 5 statutory words.

Children will also be given two 'unseen words' during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week's spelling rule.

Green: Tested on 12 words in total.

Blue: Tested on 15 words in total.

Spellings: Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

Sentence grammar focus: Using at least 5 chosen words, write 5 sentences using **apostrophes for possession**.

Remember:

Singular possession – someone owns something, add an apostrophe and 's'.

- Isla's pencil.

Plural possession – more than one person owns something. If it ends in an 's', add an apostrophe after the 's'. If it doesn't end in 's', add an apostrophe and then 's'.

- The piglets' mother.
- The people's beliefs.

E.g.

The **brilliant** camp leader was **tolerant** of the **children's behaviour**.

Remember to make sure you are **writing neatly** and using **all appropriate punctuation**.
