Both **Purple** and **Red** are to learn the 5 statutory words.

**Red:** Please learn the **Purple** and **Red** words and write them into 5 sentences.

Children will also be given two 'unseen words' during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week's spelling rule.

**Purple:** Tested on 12 words in total.

**Red:** Tested on 15 words in total.

**Spellings:** Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

**Sentence grammar focus:** For five chosen words, write five sentences that use a fronted adverbial.

For example: On a cold winter morning, the family decided to be **spontaneous** and go on a day trip to Brighton!

Remember to make sure you are **writing neatly** and using **all appropriate punctuation**.
