<b>Rule:</b> Words ending in ‘-ably’ and ‘-ibly’	<b>Statutory:</b> Year 5/6 statutory spellings

<b>Green:</b> Just learn the green words and write them into 5 sentences.  <b>Blue:</b> Learn the green and blue words and write them into 5 sentences.	Both <b>Green</b> and <b>Blue</b> are to learn the 5 statutory words.
<p>Children will also be given two ‘unseen words’ during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week’s spelling rule.</p> <p><b>Green:</b> Tested on 12 words in total.</p> <p><b>Blue:</b> Tested on 15 words in total.</p>	
<p><b>Spellings:</b> Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.</p> <p><b>Sentence grammar focus:</b> Using at least <b>5 chosen words</b>, write 5 sentences using <b>a relative clause</b> (remember relative pronouns: who, whom, whose, which, where, that).</p> <p>E.g. He <b>comfortably</b> lay in his chair, <b>which was tarnished and stained</b>, reading the journalist’s report about the boat crash.</p> <p>Remember to make sure you are <b>writing neatly</b> and using <b>all appropriate punctuation</b>.</p>	
<b>Arithmetic</b> <b>Timetables</b> Practise <b>x6, x7</b> and <b>x9</b> . Time yourself. Can you beat your time the next day? (Top Marks online has timestable practise too)	
There are also <b>Mathletics</b> tasks set.
