<p><b>Spellings:</b> Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.</p> <p><b>Sentence grammar focus:</b> Using at least <b>5 chosen words</b>, write a paragraph in the <b>simple past tense</b>. Please make sure your verbs are consistently written in the past tense form.</p> <p>The <b>wrestler began</b> his journey to the depths of Death Valley. He always <b>had</b> one aim: to ensure he <b>created</b> mass <b>wreckage</b>. His devious demeanour <b>gave</b> him high-profile status, which a famous <b>writer</b> once <b>wrote</b> about.</p> <p>Remember to make sure you are <b>writing neatly</b> and using <b>all appropriate punctuation</b>.</p>
