

Year 2 Spellings Summer 1: Week 1

Rule: To spell the /or/ sound spelled 'a' before ll and l.

Statutory:

1 all

2 call

3 walk

4 fall

5 small

6 always

7 also

8 bald

door

poor

old

cold

told

Green: Just learn the green words and write them into 3 sentences.

Blue: Learn the green and blue words and write them into 3 sentences.

Both **Green** and **Blue** are to learn the 5 statutory words.

Children will also be given two 'unseen words' during the test on Friday to assess their understanding of the week's spelling rule.

Green: Tested on 12 words in total.

Blue: Tested on 15 words in total.

Spellings: Write each of your words 3 times in your homework book to help you remember how to spell them.

Sentence grammar focus:

For **3** of your spelling words, write sentences that include a conjunction (or, and, but, when, if, that, because).

When I get home, I am going to go for a **walk** with my energetic, joyful friend.
I really want to **call** my eldest cousin **but** sadly it is too late.

The arithmetic task is in addition to the Mathematics activities that your child has been set from the fractions unit.

Find $\frac{1}{2}$ of each amount (share between two).

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 12 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 20 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$\frac{1}{2} \text{ of } 26 = \underline{\quad}$$

Find $\frac{1}{4}$ of each amount (share between four).

$$\frac{1}{4} \text{ of } 8 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$\frac{1}{4} \text{ of } 16 = \underline{\quad}$$

$$\frac{1}{4} \text{ of } 24 = \underline{\quad}$$

Challenge: Can you find one third (share between three) of 12, 18 and 21?
